1. REPORT ON COVERAGE OF UNFUNDED LIABILITY – GEORGE HARRIS

AS of March 27, the BOHR has accumulated an unfunded liability of \$609,638, including accounts payable of \$13,218.

The \$29,130 general fund loan from the Department of Administration has been paid off.

There are still outstanding accounts receivable of \$68,457. including \$50,239 from Belgrade Lounge that has now declared bankruptcy.

Deficit repayment funds cannot come from MDOL per capita or brand rerecord programs per state Law 15-24-992, MCA. Agreements were negotiated with the Department of Administration in the amounts of \$128,678 and \$480,960 to pay negative the negative fund balances prior to FYE 2011 as required by state statute. BOHR voted at the March 8 meeting to dedicate income from the Advanced Wagering and Fantasy Sports toward repayment of the loans. The loan repayment scheduled for an eight year term.

To date income from Fantasy Sports is \$28,572 and Advanced Deposit Wagering is \$36,054. For a total dedicated income of \$64,626 for the first installment toward loans repayment.

Ralph Young, 390 Rapelje Road, Columbus, MT was appointed to serve a term ending January 20, 2013. He succeeds Ray Tracy.
